

**Tender No. 21/003**

Petroleum & Energy Infrastructures Ltd. (hereinafter the “**Company**”) seeks to receive bid proposals (“**Bids**”) for the removal of sludge from its crude oil storage tanks 94 and 95 located in Kiryat Hayim (near the Haifa bay) (the “**Tank**”) including oil recovery from the sludge, and cleaning the Tank up to a “gas free” level and the treatment and disposal of the removed sludge at an authorized landfill site, all as specified in the tender documents. Only Ex-Situ (“no man entry”) methods shall be considered. In-Situ method of cleaning shall not be acceptable.

1. Preliminary Tender Conditions – the Bidder must fulfill the following criteria in order for its Bid to be considered:
 - 1.1. The Bidder has, during the past 3 (three) years prior to the Deadline for Submission of Bids, successfully completed the cleaning process of at least one floating-roof crude oil tank (herein: the “Cleaned Tank”) located in a petroleum refinery/crude oil terminal, such Cleaned Tank either operational or non-operational, in compliance with all of the following specifications: (a) The Cleaned Tank was of a minimum capacity of 10,000 CBM (Cubic Meters); (b) At least 1,000 CBM of sludge was removed from the Cleaned Tank; and (c) A proven closed-system method (“no man entry”) was used for cleaning the Cleaned Tank.
 - 1.2. Shareholders' equity of the Bidder in its 2020 audited annual financial reports was positive, and the auditors' opinion does not include a “going concern” note. If the Bidder does not yet have audited annual financial reports for the year 2020, it may fulfill this condition by its 2019 annual audited financial reports.
 - 1.3. The Bidder, or its assigned representative, participated in the mandatory Contractors’ Tour.
 - 1.4. If the Bidder is incorporated in Israel, it possesses certificates and declarations in accordance with the Law of Transactions of Public Bodies, 1976.
 - 1.5. A Bid may be submitted by a joint venture, in which case the preliminary tender conditions specified in Sections 1.1-1.3 above must be met by at least one of the partners to the joint venture that holds a stake no less than 50% in the joint venture, and the condition specified in Section 1.4 must be met by the Israeli partners.
2. The Bidder must attach to its Bid all documents proving fulfillment of the above preliminary conditions.
3. The sole criteria for selecting the winning Bidder, among Bids that meet the preliminary conditions, shall be the Bid price (100%).
4. The cleaning method/s must receive prior approval of the Israeli Ministry of Environmental Protection.



5. The period of engagement with the winning Bidder: from the effective date of the Contract signed with the winning Bidder and until the completion of the Works, as defined in the Tender documents, including any optional Works as specified therein.
6. All Bids must be placed in the Company's tender box, at the Company's offices at 3 Hasadnaot Street, Herzeliya Industrial Zone 46120, or received electronically in the inbox of the Company's dedicated email address at tender21-003@pei.co.il, no later than **March 03, 2021 Israel Standard Time**. The Company may change the deadline and shall post such notification on its website.
7. The full tender documents are available on the Company's website (www.pei.co.il).
8. The Company does not undertake to accept any Bid and reserves the right to reject any Bid, including the least costly Bid, or all the Bids. The Company may engage in negotiations with the lowest Bidder(s) at its sole discretion, in the event all valid Bids are higher than the estimate of the Company.
